HEX 101 LTD PRIVACY POLICY

Your privacy is important to HeX 101 LTD, ("HeX 101 LTD"). This Policy explains how your personal information is collected, used, and disclosed by HeX 101 LTD.

This Privacy Policy ("Privacy Policy") explains how information is collected, used and disclosed by HeX 101 LTD Inc., a company incorporated at Companies House, UK, ("HeX 101 LTD", "we", or "us"), and applies to information we collect when you use or access our online or mobile websites (www.hex101.co.uk), products, services or applications (collectively, the "HeX 101 LTD Services"), or when you otherwise interact with us. We respect the privacy rights of users and recognize the importance of protecting information collected about you.

HeX 101 LTD complies with EU's General Data Protection Regulations ("GDPR"). See the sections entitled EU-U.S. Privacy Shield, Swiss-U.S. Privacy Shield, and International Transfer, below, for further information.

WHAT WE COLLECT

We collect information from you in various ways when you use our website or correspond with us via communication services, such as email and social media. We may collect personal information that you directly enter on our website or send to us via communication services. Information we may collect includes name, email address, title, and company. In addition, when you visit our website some information may be automatically collected. For example, it is standard for your web browser to automatically send information to every website you visit including ours. That information includes your computer's Internet Protocol (IP) address, access times, browser type and language, and referring website addresses. We may also collect information about your computer's operating system and information about your usage and activity on our website. We use this information, which does not identify individual users, to administer the site, to track users' movements around the site or hosted service, to improve our products and services, and for internal recordkeeping as a whole. HOW WE USE PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

The personal information we collect allows us to provide you with our products and services, to operate and improve our website, and for other purposes described in this Policy or disclosed to you on our website or in connection with our products and services. For example, we may use the information we collect from you on our website:

- to register you for an account with us to use the Hosted Service (HeX 101 LTD Control) or HeX 101 LTD Client Application;
- to allow you to apply to become a partner or customer;
- to facilitate the provision of software updates and improve your experience on our Site;
- to respond to comments and questions and provide customer service; and
- to deliver service messages and other services and content you request and to send information related to accounts and services, including confirmations, invoices, technical notices, updates, security alerts, and support and administrative messages.

HeX 101 LTD may store and process personal information in the United States and other countries.

SHARING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We use third parties such an email service provider to send out emails on our behalf. When you sign up for our products or services, we will share the personal information you provide only as necessary for the third party to provide that service. These third parties are obligated to protect your information. We do not sell your personal information to third parties. If this practice should change in the future we will update this policy and provide individuals with opt-out or opt-in choice as appropriate prior to sharing their personal data.

We do not share your personal information with third parties other than as described in this privacy policy above and as follows:

- with third party vendors, consultants and other service providers ("Service Providers") who are working on our behalf and need access to your information to carry out their work for us;
- to (a) comply with laws or respond to lawful requests from public authorities including to meet national security and law enforcement requirements, and legal process, (b) to protect the rights and property of HeX 101 LTD, our agents and others including to enforce our agreements, policies and terms of use, or (c) in the good faith belief that disclosure is needed to respond to an emergency or protect the personal safety of any person;
- in connection with any merger, sale of company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company. In any such event, we will provide notice via email and a prominent notice on our website if your data is transferred and becomes subject to a different privacy policy; and
- to any other third party with your prior consent to do so.

EU-U.S. Privacy Shield and Swiss-U.S. Privacy Shield

HeX 101 LTD complies with the EU-U.S. Privacy Shield Framework and the Swiss-U.S. Privacy Shield Framework as set forth by the U.S. Department of Commerce regarding the collection, use, and retention of personal information transferred from the European Union, United Kingdom, and Switzerland to the United States.

HeX 101 LTD has certified to the Department of Commerce that we adhere to the Privacy Shield Principles of Notice, Choice, Accountability for Onward Transfer, Security, Data Integrity and Purpose Limitation, Access, and Recourse, Enforcement and Liability. If there is any conflict between the policies in this privacy policy and the Privacy Shield Principles, the Privacy Shield Principles shall govern. Our participation in the Privacy Shield applies to all personal data that is subject to this Privacy Policy and which is received from the EU and the European Union, European Economic Area, United Kingdom, and Switzerland. We will comply with the Privacy Shield Principles in respect of such personal data.

Our accountability for personal data that we receive under the EU-U.S. and Swiss-U.S. Privacy Shield Frameworks and subsequently transfer to a third party is described in the Privacy Shield Principles. In particular, we remain responsible and liable under the Privacy Shield Principles if third-party agents that we engage to process the personal data on our behalf do so in a manner inconsistent with the Principles, unless we prove that we are not responsible for the event giving rise to the damage. Pursuant to the Privacy Shield, HeX 101

LTD remains liable for the transfer of personal data to third parties acting as our agents unless we can prove we were not a party to the events giving rise to the damages.

We acknowledge that pursuant to the EU-U.S. and Swiss-US Privacy Shield Frameworks EU, UK and Swiss individuals have the right to access their data that is transferred into the United States. Data subjects can also update, amend or change inaccurate information and request deletion of data that is found to have been processed in violation of the Privacy Shield Principles. HeX 101 LTD is subject to the investigatory and enforcement powers of the U.S. Federal Trade Commission (FTC).

INTERNATIONAL TRANSFERS

TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES

Tracking technologies such as: cookies, beacons, tags and scripts are used by HeX 101 LTD, our website analytics and service partners such as Google Analytics, HubSpot or Salesforce. We use Local Storage (LS) such as HTML5 to store content information to provide certain features on our website. Various browsers may offer their own management tools for removing HTML5 LS.

We partner with a third party to manage our advertising on other sites. Our third party partner may use technologies such as cookies to gather information about your activities on this site and other sites in order to provide you advertising based upon your browsing activities and interests.

SECURITY OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

The security of your personal information is important to us and we are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorized access or disclosure, we have put in place reasonable suitable administrative, technical, and physical measures and procedures to safeguard and secure your personal information against loss, theft, and misuse, as well as against unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, and destruction.
